


FALL 2017 BENTLEY UNIVERSITY OPEN HOUSE

SET UP YOUR SMARTPHONE

Set up your smartphone to receive signals from several beacons placed around campus. As you approach a beacon, your phone will receive a link to a webpage with information about events happening near you. Tap the link to view each page.

Follow the configuration steps for iPhone or Android below, depending on your smartphone.

	iPhone Users
1	Install the Google Chrome app on your smartphone if you don't have it already. Enable Bluetooth .
2	Swipe down on the Home Screen to open the Notification Center. Swipe right on your home screen to view the Today screen. Scroll down to tap the Edit button.
3	Tap the  button next to the Chrome widget to add to your menu. Tap Done .
4	Tap Show More on the Chrome widget.   Tap the Ok, got it button if it appears.

	Android Users
1	Install the Google Chrome app on your smartphone if you don't have it already. Enable Bluetooth .
2	Enable Location: Tap Settings > Applications (or Apps) > Chrome > Permissions > Location .
3	Enable Nearby Notifications: Tap Settings > Google > Nearby Notifications .

Your phone now will receive beacon notifications. Check throughout the day, and tap each notification from **BentleyOH** to visit a webpage with information about activities happening nearby.
